COVID-19 PROTOCOLS FOR THE 36TH ANNUAL TRI-STATE SEMINAR

August 9-12, 2021

Revision Date: July 30, 2021

The Tri-State Seminar, LLC (TSSLLC) acknowledges an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

In an effort to limit exposure for our volunteers and participants to the COVID-19 virus at the 36th Annual Tri-State Seminar, the following protocols have been adopted:

1. TSSLLC will follow current CDC Guidelines, local directives issued by the State of Nevada, Clark County, and the Southern Nevada Health District, as well as mitigation measures implemented by the seminar venue, South Point Hotel and Casino (South Point), to limit exposure and spread of the COVID-19 virus among TSSLLC volunteers and seminar attendees. In case of conflicting requirements, the most stringent and current guidelines, directives, and mitigation measures will be followed. [South Point's COVID-19 Protocols](#)
2. Effective July 30, 2021, the State of Nevada issued a mask mandate. The mandate requires that individuals wear a mask when indoors, regardless of vaccination status. TSSLLC will provide free masks to all volunteers and seminar attendees and will require their use throughout the seminar. [State of Nevada Press Release](#)
3. The Nevada Gaming Control Board, which governs the activities at South Point Hotel and Casino, issued the following guidance, also effective July 30, 2021:

Resorts must make sure all employees, patrons, and guests properly utilize face coverings indoors. Casinos must also put up signage indicating masks are required.

The mitigation measures implemented by South Point include the posting of signage throughout high traffic areas of the hotel, and specifically in seminar areas such as registration, exhibit hall, and conference center. [Nevada Gaming Board Press Release](#)
